AIIMS was recently used in the Daly River community evacuation and was very effective in achieving a suitable and safe outcome for affected residents.

Councillors' Corner

The Vic Daly Regional Council will be holding two International Women's Day events. These activities are made possible due to a successful grant application from the Hon. Dale Wakefield, Minister for Territory Families. A dinner will be held at the Pine Creek Hotel on Tuesday 6 March at 6.30pm. On Wednesday 7 March, a morning tea will be hosted at Kybrook community. Both events will feature quest speakers; woman who have made a contribution in their field. Our first Pine Creek Local Authority meeting for 2018 will be held on Wednesday 7 March commencing at 6pm. The meeting is open to all Pine Creek residents. A workshop will also be incorporated into the meeting agenda on the first phase of developing our Regional Plan. Our Regional Plan is a document developed by the community to focus on 'wish list' and prioritise projects and activities for the next financial year

Work is progressing on the upgrade of the Pine Creek Dump. Council has a strategy for waste Management in our Council Region to move away from dumping at a face. The model will feature waste transfer stations, recycling areas, fencing and development of above ground refuse cells and leachate control ponds. Kalkarindji and Yarralin will be developed first due to successful funding of \$0.647M and Pine Creek and Nauiyu when grant funding available.

The next meeting of the Vic Daly Regional Council will be held in Pine Creek on Tuesday 27 March 2018.
